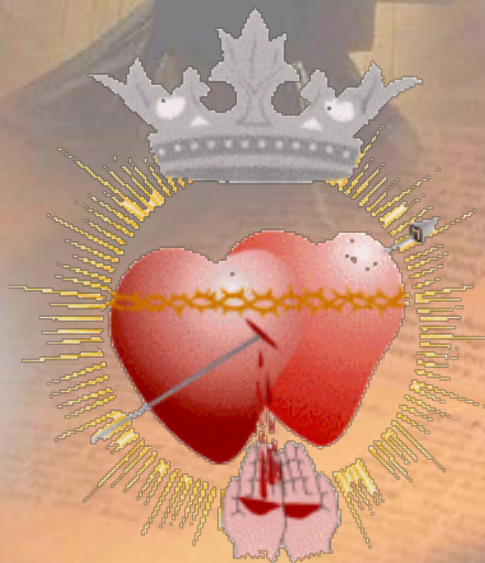
What religious sisters or nuns wear as a sign of their total consecration to God. It makes and identifies the particular community to which the religious belongs.
