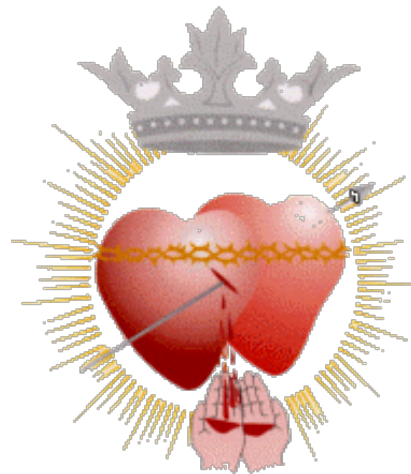

Our Apostolic Charism

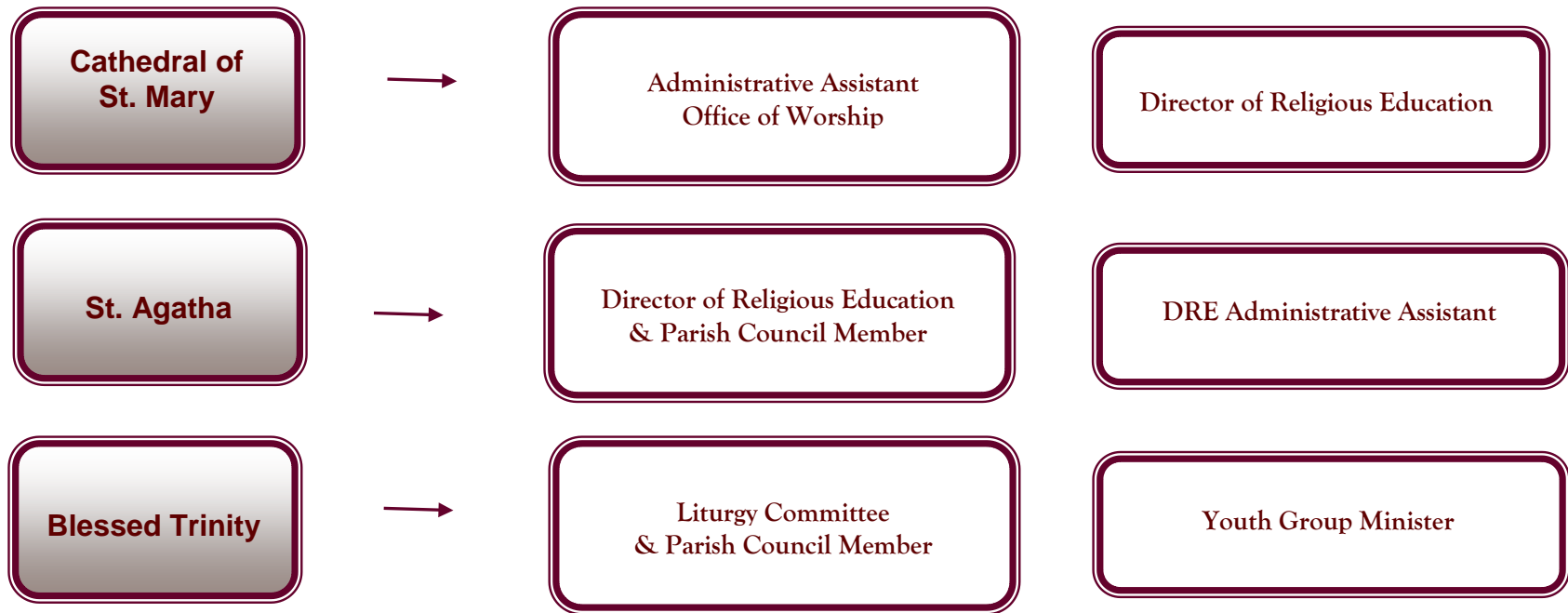
